## **Important roadworks information**

Dear Sir/Madam,

### **A11/A47 Thickthorn interchange to Ipswich Road interchange, Cringleford: major project survey works**

I write to inform you that Kier will be undertaking survey works at the above location on behalf of Highways England. These surveys will allow us to gain valuable information on the existing ground and network condition, helping Highways England design and programme future works necessary for improving the strategic road network.

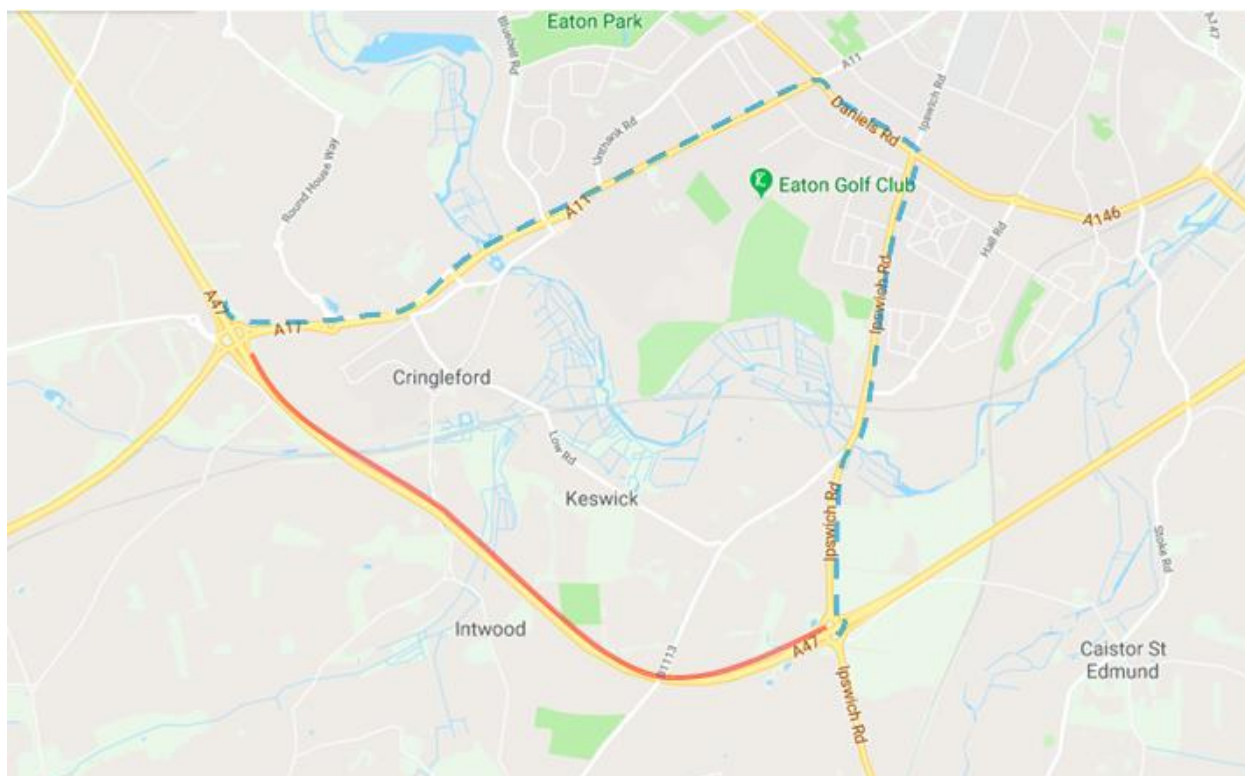
We plan to start this work on Friday 27 April, with working hours of **8pm to 6am**, weeknights only, weather permitting. Work will finish on Thursday 10 May at 6am. Please note works will not occur on May bank holiday Monday, 7 May. A full eastbound closure of the A47 between Thickthorn interchange and Ipswich Road interchange will be in place during these works.

Please note that over the next four months other overnight closures will be in place, such as slip lane closures, single lane closures and temporary traffic signals. In the event of slip road closures, traffic will be clearly diverted to turnaround at the next junction.

### **Diversion Route**

Traffic will be diverted from the A47 eastbound at Thickthorn interchange via A11 Newmarket Road northbound towards Norwich, A146 Daniels Road eastbound, A140 Ipswich Road southbound, before re-joining the A47 at Ipswich Road interchange.
