



Notes from meeting 2nd June 2014 at Jubilee Hall

1. Apologies received from Peter Treglown, Lynn Fielder, Barbara Bye and Linda Smith. Chairman welcomed Mike Harding, Colin McCormick, Robert Cooper and Stephen Piper to the meeting.

2. Feedback from the Parish meeting was felt to be favourable although, despite the 'Vision' and 'Objectives' having been put on to the village website as promised, the only feedback since the Parish Meeting had been from Broadland District Council who had commented that they had had a look through the objectives and the discussion document and it all looked like good, positive planning.

The only thing they raised was that it was not particularly clear in Objective 6 whether additional sites are going to be allocated for housing within the Neighbourhood Plan or not. This may not have been resolved at the moment but the way it's currently worded implies that sites have been found and will be allocated. In addition (looking at the discussion document), there may be some difficulties in terms of what can actually be achieved through the planning system - e.g. preventing letting of properties.

We discussed ways of getting feedback from the residents and it was agreed that an article and 'flyer' would be put into the next edition of Saga (July) – *NT, PT and CD to deal with this (mtg. arranged for 18/6).*

We would follow this by meeting with village groups e.g. W.I., Mardlers, Youth Club etc.

When comment and feedback received we would then hold an open day and talk with smaller groups on different topics. Following that we could start to 'flesh out' the detail.

3. We still need to confirm the NP area with BDC. After discussion agreed that we would revert to the whole parish area – although we could have little influence over the part of the parish within the plans for the Rackheath development we would not wish to exclude the area - *JB to provide a revised map for NT to submit with appropriate narrative to BDC.*

4. NT read an Email from Alby Cator confirming the resignation of his Estate Manager and that he would now personally be taking that role over. Agreed that as soon as we had formulated more concrete plans we need to discuss with Alby and Henry again. RC pointed out that we should also meet the Salhouse United Charities at some stage.

5. C McC. Advised on the situation with the latest site allocations document from BDC and left a copy of the BDC Site Allocations DPD and the Development Management DPD with NT for future reference.
6. NT advised that he, PT and JB would be attending a meeting at BDC on 12th June – they are restarting the Neighbourhood Plan Networking workshops and this is the first.
7. We discussed whether to employ a consultant to help with the plan. Agreed that we should look into this but we very careful about terms of reference.
8. Date of next Salhouse 2020+ group meeting arranged for **14th July at Jubilee Hall.**
